- ◆ The Kids in Crisis (KIC) Project assists children with disabilities and their families.
- ◆ The KIC Project can inform families of children with disabilities about the services available to them and help them gain access to those services.
- ◆ We provide free, confidential legal services to San Mateo County children and youth ages 0-18 with mental or physical disabilities and their families.
